### **TWO NEW CANONS APPOINTED**

Bishop Bruce Myers is pleased to announce the appointment of two new canons who will be charged with helping equip the people and congregations of the Diocese of Quebec to grow in their Christian discipleship and to participate more fully in God's mission in and for the world. As Canon Theologian, the Rev. Canon Jeffrey Metcalfe will serve as a theological advisor to the bishop and diocesan decision-making bodies, helping ensure that everything we do as a church is reflected upon in the light of scripture, tradition, and reason. As Canon for Lay Ministries, the Rev. Canon Giuseppe Gagliano will principally support and oversee the work of lay readers, who are vital in the provision of ministry in many parts of the diocese. Both appointments will take effect on July 1, 2017. The new canons will be formally installed at the Cathedral of the Holy Trinity in Quebec City at a later date.
