DEANERY SERVICE JANUARY 29

As an act of solidarity with our persecuted Christian brothers and sisters, and as a witness to the deepening friendship between our two faith communities, we will join the Syrian Orthodox congregation for their Sunday morning service. Their Archbishop will be there to welcome us. The service begins at 10:30 am at St Ephrem's Syrian Orthodox Church at 150 13th Avenue South (Just off King East) in Sherbrooke. Please come with us to explore a different expression of the faith of the church, expand your horizons, hear their glorious music as we give thanks for our mutual work for refugees and show our solidarity and affection.

A booklet that explains the service and the Syrian Christian Tradition (*First Visit to an Orthodox Church: 12 Things I Wish I'd Known*) will be provided at the service. If you would like one beforehand, please contact the Archdeacon. For those wishing to look over the actual service beforehand the Archdeacon will provide you with an English translation. It is not customary for non-Orthodox to receive Communion when attending these services. The offering at the service will be for the Syrian Refugee Project and given directly to St Ephrem's.

As the Syrian community provided the splendid food for our last gathering, it is now our turn. Donations to help fund the luncheon the DMC will provide would be appreciated and should be given through your local parish.

A bus will be available to provide transportation to the church and will leave St George's, Lennoxville at 10:00 am returning at 2:00 pm. Reservations are not required.

Services are cancelled at churches in the Regional Ministry on January 29.
