FLOWERING THE CROSS – ST BARNABAS, NORTH HATLEY

This Easter Sunday we will be flowering the cross again. You will have an opportunity to adorn the bare wooden cross from Good Friday with flowers. The flowered cross will then be placed outside following the service for our community to enjoy. This will be our witness to others that Christ is risen indeed!

Please bring a couple of fresh or artificial flowers, or greenery, with you to church. You may place them on the cross when you enter the church. Chicken wire encases the cross so the stems can be pushed through an opening.
